Dr. Shivang Trivedi, F.A.C.C., F.A.S.N.C. joined Cardiology Associates of Somerset County in July 2004. Dr. Trivedi's areas of interest within his specialty of Cardiology include preventative cardiology, management of patients with coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathy and valvular heart disease.
